



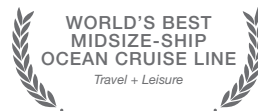

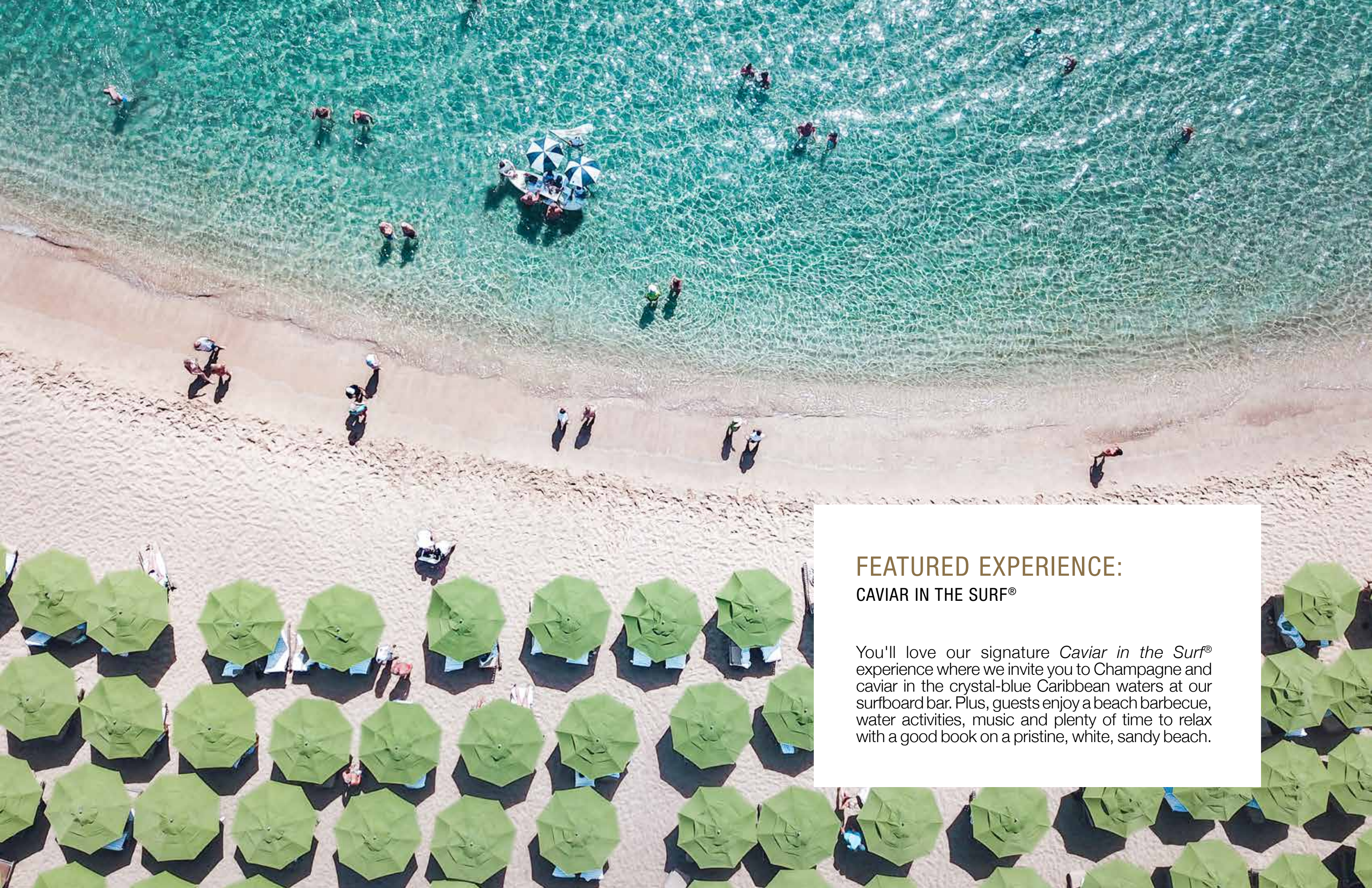

PORT ROYAL, JAMAICA

You'll want to venture underwater to see all of this 17th-century pirate city and shipwreck off the shores of Kingston. The Giddy House of Fort Charles and other above-ground monuments from the era can also be toured.

HILLSBOROUGH, CARRIACOU, GRENADA

A tiny Caribbean town with plenty of extra charm, Hillsborough is a lovely off-the-beaten-path place to enjoy Arawak and Carib cultural artifacts and handiworks, a number of botanical gardens, and regatta-style sailing.

CARAMBOLA BEACH, ST. KITTS

Prized as one of the island's most exclusive stretches of beachfront, Carambola is the perfect location for our signature *Caviar in the Surf*® beach barbecue experience.

TERRE-DE-HAUT, ÎLES DES SAINTES, GUADELOUPE

The îles des Saintes, a tiny cluster of islets off the southern coast of Guadeloupe is what the doctor ordered. Stroll around Bourg de Saintes, shop for real French cosmetics, and revel in the weather.

GREAT HARBOUR, JOST VAN DYKE, BRITISH VIRGIN ISLANDS

ST. JOHN'S, ANTIGUA

Antigua is blessed with shining white beaches, and top-end resort hotels that engender golf courses and other amenities counted among the best in the Caribbean. Take a drive to the commanding fortress on Shirley Heights.

TROIS ÎLETS, MARTINIQUE

Trois îlets just across the Bay of Fort-de-France from the capital. Fort-de-France is a bustling seaport and market town, with handsome reminders of its colonial past including the ornate Schoelcher Library imported stone-by-stone from France.

WILLEMSTAD, CURAÇAO

As the capital of the Netherlands Antilles, gabled buildings and countryside windmills bring to mind Dutch cities of Europe. And yet, vibrant streetscapes, duty-free shopping, beaches, and flamingos in the wild make this town distinctly tropical.

KRALENDIJK, BONAIRE

As the second-highest-rated snorkeling and dive site in the world, the coral reefs of Bonaire are not to be missed. On land, the waterfront promenade, boutiques, and duty-free shops of Breedestraat are Dutch colonial delights.

CHARLOTTEVILLE, TOBAGO

Trinidad's "little sister" Tobago welcomes you with a fishing village set on a curve of beach on Man-o-war Bay. Most visitors bask in the laid-back atmosphere, and swim, snorkel or dive in the surrounding waters.



WILLEMSTAD, CURAÇAO



GUSTAVIA, ST. BARTS

Gustavia's harbor is a favorite stop for sailing yachts, and the majority of visitors to the island are the privileged who treasure its laid-back chic and small-gem perfection.

PORT ELIZABETH, BEQUIA

Bequia's Admiralty Bay is a favorite yachtsman's anchorage. Stroll along the Belmont Walkway to the Gingerbread for homemade frangipani. Continue to Princess Margaret Beach or Lower Bay. Witness excellent craftsmanship at the Sargeant Brothers Model Boat Shop.

SOPER'S HOLE, FRENCHMAN'S CAY, BRITISH VIRGIN ISLANDS

This snug harbor at the West End of Tortola is the classic Caribbean yacht haven. There are numerous restaurants, cafés and bars for people-watching and yarn-spinning.

SALINE BAY, MAYREAU

At this idyllic islet in the Tobago Cays, we often anchor and indulge in a water sports Marina Day.*

BASSE-TERRE, GUADELOUPE

Basse-Terre is located on the smaller of Guadeloupe's two "butterfly wing" lobes. The island offers many picturesque fishing villages now welcoming tourists, including Deshaise near Grand Anse beach and Saint Claude in the forested hills.

BASSETERRE, ST. KITTS

St. Kitts offers quiet beaches, remnants of the old British plantation culture, and dreamy days under silk-cotton trees, soothed by the scents of flamboyants and frangipani.

TRANSITING THE PANAMA CANAL

This daylight crossing gives you an uncommon glimpse of the Panama Canal. The impressive mechanics floats the ship through locks at multiple elevations, leisurely moving from one end of the canal to the other. You'll glide from dynamic port cities into remote countryside and farmlands before exiting to another modern cityscape, seeing yesterday and today in rare fashion.

SAN JUAN DEL SUR, NICARAGUA

Decidedly stress-free, travelers adore the friendly energy here. Sail catamarans along pristine beaches. Backpack up to one of the world's largest Jesus statues, or sip cocktails on the shore. You'll always feel welcome.

QUEPOS, COSTA RICA

Puerto Quepos, originally built as a banana exporting port, now handles mainly the export of palm oil. The coastal area south of Quepos has been developed for tourism and there are now a number of hotels in the area.

BELIZE CITY, BELIZE

Located at the center of the country, Belize City boasts an array of historic attractions – St. John's Cathedral, the Swing Bridge, Government House Museum and the colorful fruit market.

BANANA COAST (TRUJILLO), HONDURAS

This port on Honduras's Caribbean coast has a Central Plaza, the Cathedral of St. John the Baptist and the Campo del Mar Nature Park. Explore on ATVs, snorkel on coral reefs, or zipline from tree to tree.

BOCA DEL TORO, PANAMA

First established in the 1920s for banana operations, this cluster of islands has lovely beaches, mangrove waterways to kayak, multiple native cultures, abundant wildlife, and access to the Parque Internacional La Amistad, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

PUNTARENAS (PUERTO CALDERA), COSTA RICA

The Monteverde Reserve, the famous woodcarving center of Sarchi, and the highland town of Grecia are top attractions here, as are the nearby Carara National Park, home of the "Pura Vida" waterfall and brilliant scarlet macaws.

GOLFITO, COSTA RICA

Golfito is the gateway to the Piedras Blancas National Park. The park is one of Costa Rica's top birding spots. South of Golfito stretch beaches that are world famous among surfers. Golfito is also famous for its sportfishing, especially sailfish.
