FEATURED PORTS AND HIGHLIGHTS

LAHAINA, MAUI, HAWAII

West Maui's golden beaches overlook Molokai and Lanai, while whales, turtles and manta rays glide just beneath its waters. The charming high street features local coffee, cafés, trendy boutiques and hand-carved woodworks.

HILO, HAWAII

"The Big Island" offers plenty of attractions from Punalu'u Black Sand Beach to the observatory on the peak of Mauna Kea. Other choices include Rainbow Falls, Liliuokalani Japanese Gardens and the active Kilauea caldera.

HONOLULU, OAHU, HAWAII

Honolulu's glittering skyline stretches over iconic Waikiki Beach, bustling with energy, shops, restaurants and modern fun. Just outside downtown, Diamondhead, palaces and gardens, and Pearl Harbor pay tribute to the past.



HUMPBACK WHALE, LAHAINA, HAWAII

AVATORU, RANGIROA, FRENCH POLYNESIA

Perched on a Pacific atoll, Rangiroa offers unforgettable diving and snorkeling with dolphins, whales and even sharks. For drier pursuits on land, sample the local wine or visit the steeped churches made of coral stone.

MATAIVA, FRENCH POLYNESIA

Few places offer such an authentic glimpse of Polynesian life as Mataiva – where the remnants of the Marae Papiro temple and the tiny village of Pahua stand untouched by time and the trappings of today.

VAITAPE, BORA-BORA, FRENCH POLYNESIA

While its crystalline waters and powder-soft beaches are sights to behold, Vaitape has other surprises like the Marae Fare-Opu temple ruins and the massive WWII Coastal Defence Guns that are worth the short hike.

PAPEETE, TAHITI, FRENCH POLYNESIA

Between wading the shallow lagoon with your snorkel and dive mask, and meandering the lush hillside nature trails, be sure not to miss Papeete's lively gathering of food trucks in the city's main square.

DRAVUNI ISLAND, FIJI

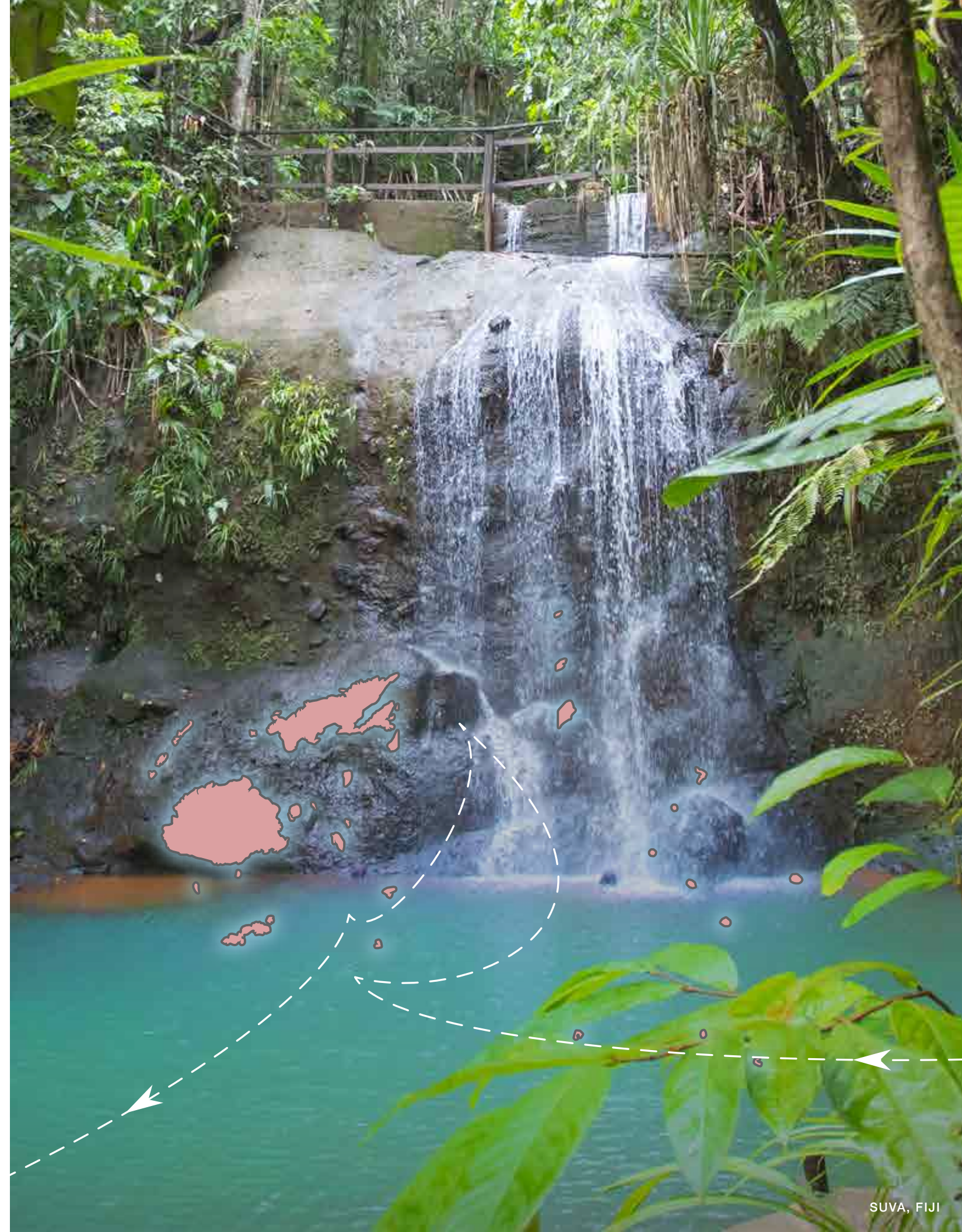

SUVA, FIJI

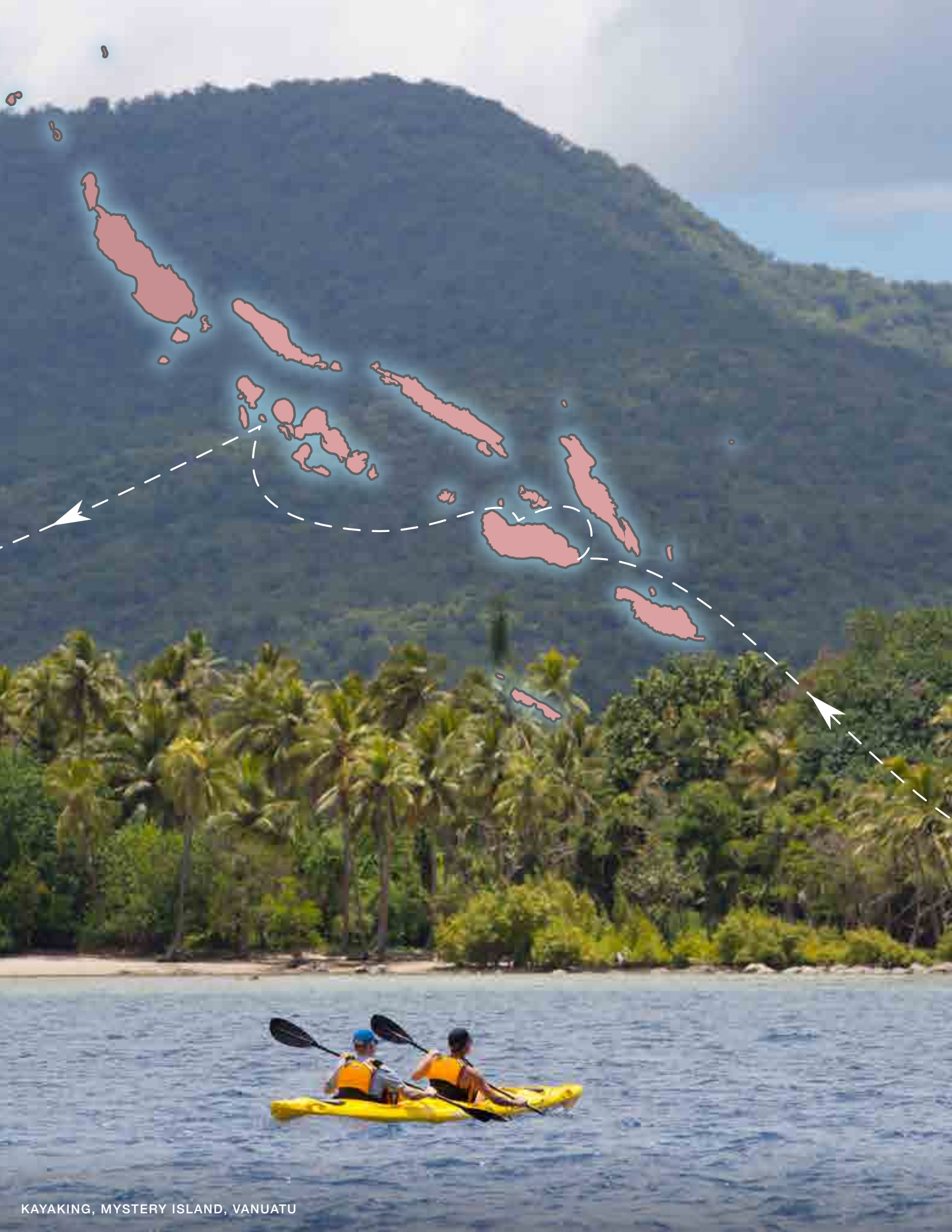

INYEUNG ISLET (MYSTERY ISLAND), VANUATU

Mystery Island is a tiny uninhabited islet which acts as a castaway-type resort with water sports, cultural activities, local handcrafts, snorkeling, swimming, hiking or simply relaxing in a South Pacific paradise.

GHIZO ISLAND, SOLOMON ISLANDS

Impressive dive sites include wreckage of WWII planes amidst the dazzling coral reefs and abundant tropical fish. On land, the market offers delicious fruits and treats, wood carvings, and high-fives from local children.

HONIARA, SOLOMON ISLANDS

History and culture buffs are fascinated by this South Seas port which hosts a US War Memorial to the battles of Guadalcanal, a Melanesian National Museum, botanical gardens, and wood-stalled street markets.



KAYAKING, MYSTERY ISLAND, VANUATU

SPINNER DOLPHINS, SOLOMON ISLANDS

CONFLICT ISLANDS, (PANAWAL GROUP), PAPUA NEW GUINEA

A cluster of 21 islets surround a deep lagoon and coral reefs teeming with marine life. Turtles, iconic reef fish, manta rays, and even orcas can be seen here while scuba diving, snorkeling or by glass-bottom boat.

CAIRNS, AUSTRALIA

Wild at heart and friendly by nature, this northern city is the gateway to the Daintree Rainforest, the Tjapukai Aboriginal Culture Park, the village of Kurunda, and encounters with platypus and crocodile.

TRANSITING THE PANAMA CANAL

In the pantheon of iconic travel experiences, a transit of the twisting waterways and mighty locks of the Panama Canal ranks near the top.

FUERTE AMADOR (PANAMA CITY), PANAMA

Where the Panama Canal joins the Pacific sits the capital city of Fuerte Amador. More commonly known as Panama City, this overnight port offers insight into the Canal's history, the city's time as a Spanish fort and its present-day role as a major shipping destination and global center of research, business and entertainment.

MANTA (QUITO), ECUADOR

Manta is a commercial center for fish and fruit, particularly bananas and plantains. However its beaches, vibrant culture and quaint fishing villages have long attracted tourists. Shrimp, tuna and giant blue and striped marlin are abundant in the waters off its coastal plain.

ISLAS GUAÑAPE, PERU

A cluster of four tiny islands off the coast of Peru are uninhabited by people, but are teeming with wildlife – particularly seabirds such as Humboldt penguins, blue-footed boobies, terns, and Southern sea lions who frequent these protected lands and waters.

CALLAO (LIMA), PERU

Visit Lima, the “City of Kings” and a UNESCO World Heritage Site, prized for its grand palaces and churches, broad plazas, and unique style of art that blends classical forms with native traditions.

GENERAL SAN MARTIN (PISCO), PERU

Pisco dates from 1640, its Plaza de Armas is a Spanish colonial treasure. Another treasure are the Ballestas Islands, an offshore cluster of rocky outcroppings teeming with seabirds, penguins, sea lions, dolphins and other wildlife.

ISLA PAN DE AZÚCAR, CHILE

“Sugar Loaf Island” is a nature sanctuary where breeding colonies of sea lions, sea otters, pelicans and other flora and fauna live peacefully among the rocky shores and arid climate influenced by the nearby Atacama Desert. Floating offshore, you’ll be in a prime spot to see them all.

SAN ANTONIO (SANTIAGO), CHILE

This large, modern port serves Chile’s capital, Santiago, a city with Spanish colonial charm and a vivacious spirit. Encircled by the Andes and the Coastal Range, Santiago is centered around the Plaza de Armas, with several of the city’s landmarks: the 18th-century Metropolitan Cathedral the Palacio de la Real Audencia from 1808, the City Hall and the National Museum of History.

PUERTO MONTT, CHILE

Captivating volcanic peaks, Chilean fjords, a vibrant fish market and harbor, and a bustling town-like atmosphere are all part of the colorful experience here. Explore white-water rafting, fly-fishing and hiking, or meander through craft stalls of handmade goods as you discover this multifaceted Pacific port.

THE SOUTH GEORGIA EXPERIENCE

Largely untouched and blessed with a sub-Antarctic climate and nutrient-rich seas, South Georgia is strikingly green with vegetation and teeming with wildlife, including massive populations of king and other penguin species, fur seals, elephant seals, albatrosses, giant petrels and other seabirds. Whales, orcas and dolphins abound offshore in the most diverse marine ecosystem on earth. Your Captain and Expedition Leader plan your days in South Georgia to offer you a variety of amazing experiences, based on conditions and wildlife reports. Your Expedition Team members accompany you on landings at the various sites in complimentary Zodiacs® and excursions.

NEW ISLAND, FALKLAND ISLANDS

Wind-swept New Island, one of the world's most remote inhabited islands, lies on the western fringe of the Falklands Archipelago. A place of colorful landscapes, New Island supports some of the largest concentrations and diversity of wildlife in the Falklands, with over forty species of nesting birds. Four species of penguins, including 13,000 gentoo and 26,000 Southern rockhopper penguins call the island home. Embracing winds and seas below, 60,000 black-browed albatross soar along the cliffs. Complimentary Zodiac® and optional kayak excursions enhance your experience.

THE ANTARCTIC EXPERIENCE

You will never forget your first sighting of Antarctica and its islands. For the next five days, your Captain and Expedition Leader plan your itinerary, complimentary Zodiac® landings, scenic cruising and exploration operations to offer you the widest variety of experiences possible based on conditions and wildlife reports. DEVIL'S ISLAND, FRENCH GUIANA

BUENOS AIRES, ARGENTINA

Fashionable Porteños live in style, preferring good food, fine wines and well-cut clothing. Lively and sophisticated, their city is Latin America's most European. Stroll the park-like Recoleta Cemetery to Evita Peron's flower-strewn tomb.

RIO DE JANEIRO, BRAZIL

THE AMAZON

DEVIL'S ISLAND, FRENCH GUIANA

Best recognized today as the site of the remote 19th-century prison from the movie "Papillon," Devil's Island in French Guiana is a mix of haunting ruins in a paradise-like landscape abundant with wildlife.

ARMAÇÃO DOS BÚZIOS, BRAZIL

Around the corner from Rio de Janeiro, this strand of 23 different stunning beaches and waters is perfect for snorkeling, fishing and even surfing. Like any great beach town, Buzios also offers a laid-back restaurant, shopping, and entertainment scene under sunny skies.

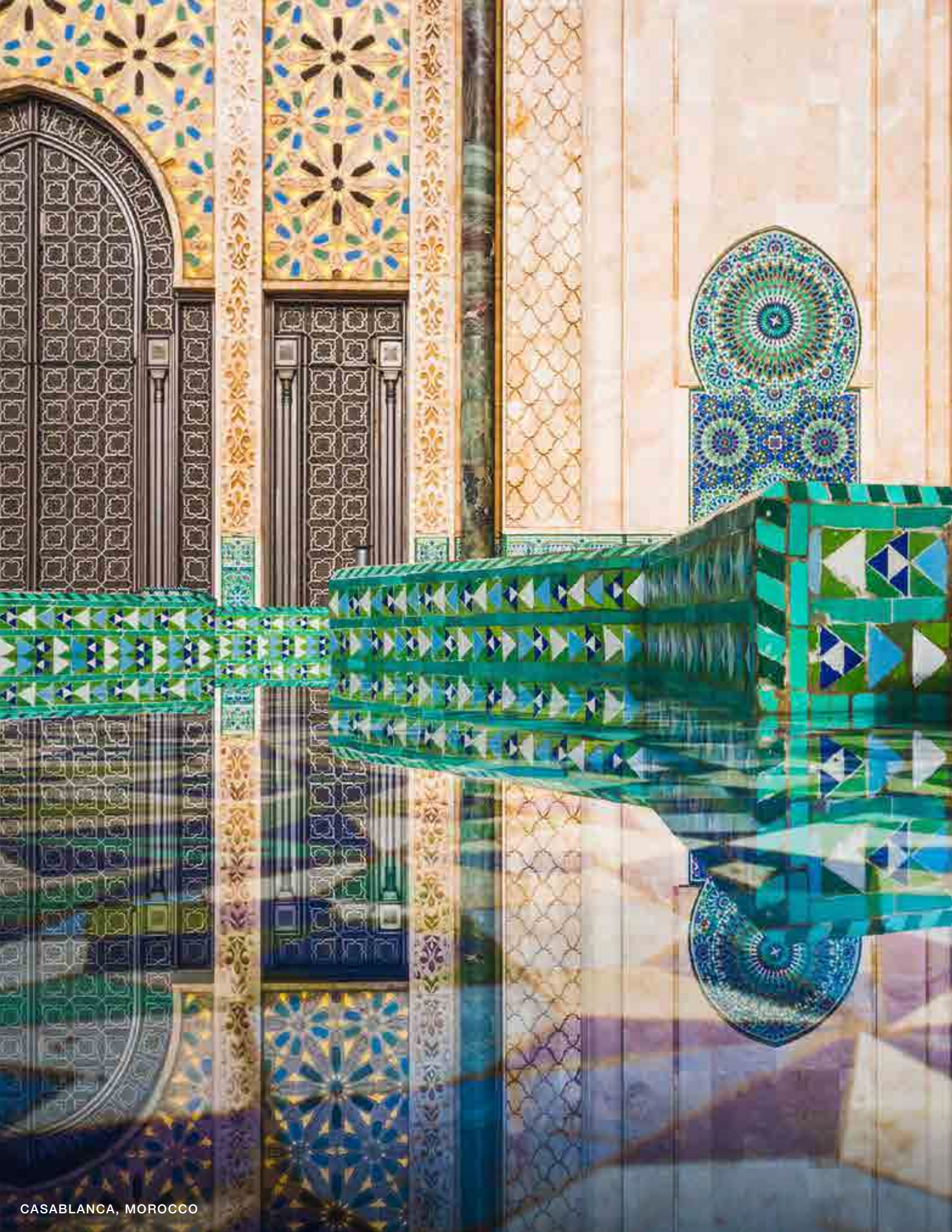

This pristine, ocean outpost is a diverse land of emerald rain forests, a volcano, sugar-sand beaches, friendly culture, and crystal-clear lagoons. Trek through the colorful jungle on 4x4, sail the sparkling harbor, join in native song and dance, and experience the pure essence of the Pacific.

TAVANIPUPU, SOLOMON ISLANDS

This 32-acre slice of paradise with warm, clear waters, lush coral reefs and soft sand beaches is located on the Marau Sound near Guadalcanal in the Solomon Islands. It is a privately owned resort, originally purchased in exchange for some ammunition by a party of Norwegian traders who operated a coconut plantation. Some of their gravestones are still to be found among the tall grasses.

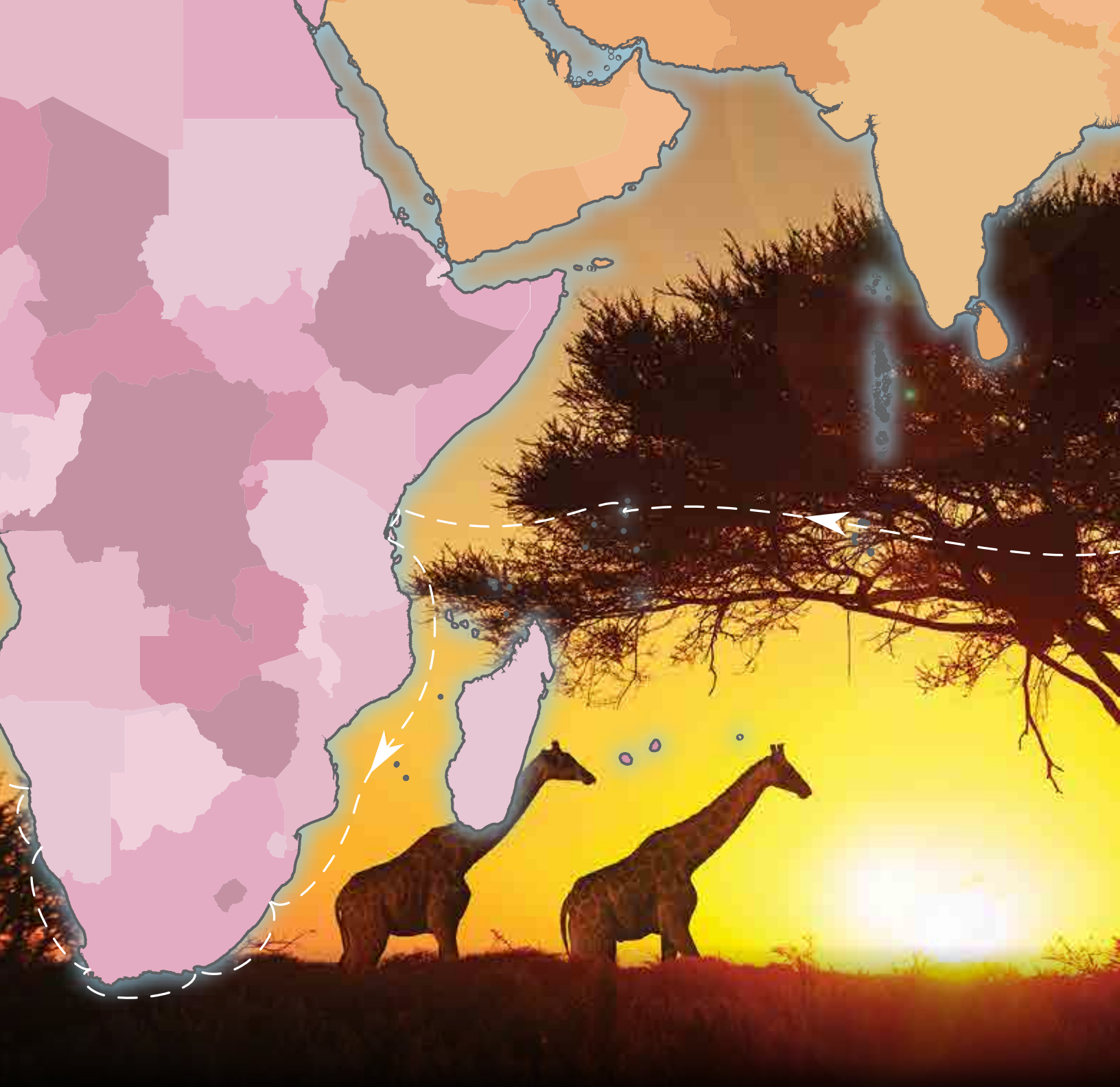

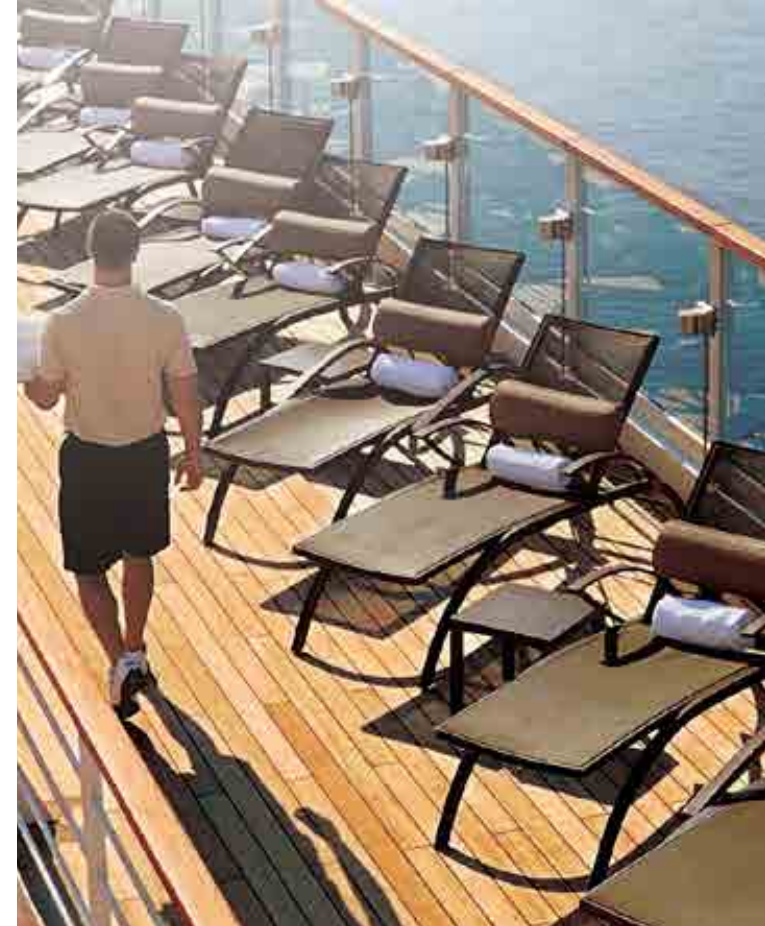

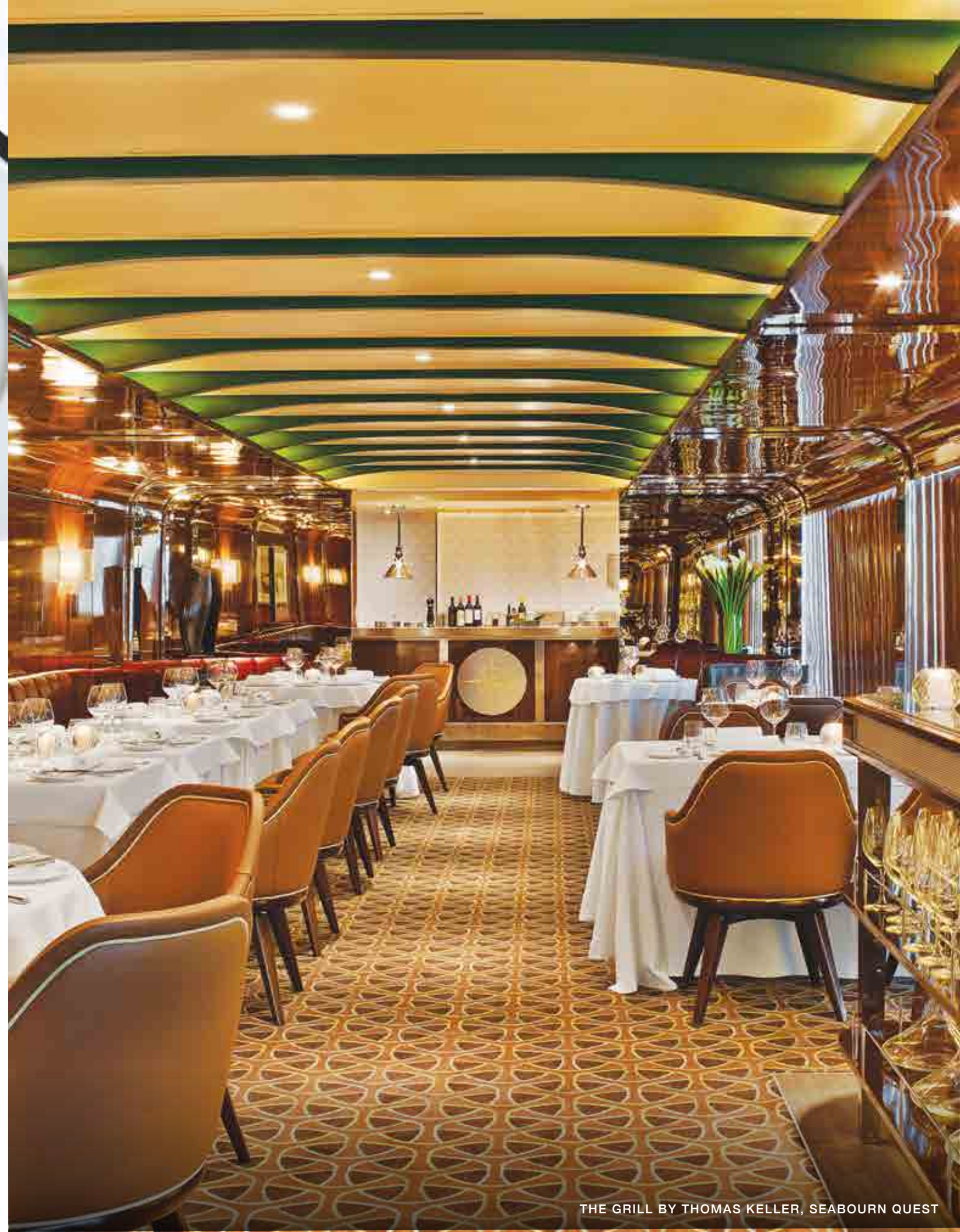
